X. Presentation from: Henry Newman with the Black Farmers Association

Mr. Henry Newman – addressed the forum and introduced himself and thanked the Board for the opportunity to come before them with this presentation. Mr. Newman stated they are affiliated with the 20/20 Black Farmers. Mr. Newman advised the Board that Reverand Davis would be coming forward to present some information beneficial to Black farmers.

Reverand Earl Davis – addressed the forum and shared with the attendees his appreciation in allowing them to present this information.

Rev. Davis -stated under the Biden administration there is a lot of money being passed around through the Department of Agriculture to help farmers and a lot of people don't know about it, what we are beginning to find out about.

Rev. Earl Davis – advised the forum there is an organization called the 20/20 Black Farmers Cooperative that organization has been around for 4 years, they are 501 C3 organization. About 2 months ago they were in Morehous Parish, what happened there was an opportunity which they were offering every farmer a settlement offers of \$ 50,000. You really didn't have to have a whole lot of documentation to receive the funds you needed to be able to tell your story, but what we found out was that most of the people were intimidated by the application which is a 40-sum odd application. Two companies went and got a contract with the federal government, to help with technical assistance because they realized the farmers really didn't have time to fill out the applications because they were dealing with the actual farm work. It was Analytic Acquisitions and another one and those two said they would help farmers to get the submission done. What I need from you guys is to do is tell me what your problems are and what you need.

The Black Farmers Cooperative has a survey and if you take that survey the Black Farmers Cooperative will provide you with one (1) free year membership. The advantage of that Co-op is first of all we operate a marketing co-op that promotes staff, integral agriculture opportunities for black farmers nationwide.
